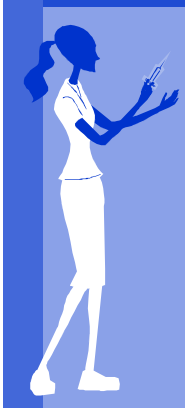


The Baffins Surgery NEWSLETTER 3
